Introduction

Your animals can be your best friends in life. Just like us, they also have their unique personalities. We may not always know their exact time of birth but we can still look at the chart for the day of birth and determine an incredible amount of information. If the exact time is unavailable a Sun sign chart will be used as the basis for the chart. We can benefit by knowing where our pets' full potential might be met. And like our human friends there may also be difficult areas of their personalities, which we must learn to accept or correct. Not all dogs are

suited for agility or obedience. Some will do better at guarding their masters; others might behave well in conformation. By understanding the potential of our dogs we seek ways to improve what already exists and accept things that are sometimes unchangeable or a challenge.

There are 4 basic elements that make up a chart; they are earth, water, air and fire. If Max has 4 or more planets in one of these elements he is considered to have more than average. By giving a weight or number to these planets we can determine if the chart has tendencies that would be influenced by being overweighted in that particular element. The Ascendant, Midheaven and planets on the angles are also given a number, which is included in determining the makeup of a chart.

This birth chart interpretation is based on the positions of the planets at the time of your birth. For the benefit of students of astrology, these positions, along with other technical information, are listed below:

Element Emphasis

Air Sign Emphasis: (Score of 4,6,8,10)

Max has an abundance of air in his chart. This makes Max high-strung and ready for action. He could run circles around you and other animals in the household. Tuned in to your every movement, Max senses when you're ready to move or do anything he can be included in. Max needs to have a job that will put his intelligence to use constructively. If left alone, Max can display destructive tendencies due to boredom. Leave the TV or radio on when alone so his active mind has some stimuli to keep negative behavior away. Give him a job. Herding other small animals or occasionally watching over children could be just what he needs to keep

his busy mind active. As a companion pet, Max proves very entertaining and can be the life of the party. The social element or diplomat in a house of other pets. Max loves to travel and will beat you to the door when he hears keys rattle.

Ascendant

The ascendant, or sign on the horizon at birth, changes approximately every 2 hours. To get a true picture of an animal a time of birth is very helpful. From the ascendant, not only do we learn the appearance and characteristics of an animal, we also derive a pattern for the chart itself. The ascendant is the face we show to strangers, animal and human alike. We may view Max as his Sun sign, but others will see the sign on the ascendant. The rising sign dictates how Max portrays himself to others. These characteristics are entirely different from what we see on the home front. Learn more about how others see Max.

Cancer Rising:

Large round face and expressive eyes could be how you describe Max. If Max could pick his favorite place it would have to be the kitchen. Never far from the mother of the household. If upset or scolded Max sometimes looks like he is crying. He will come to your side and try to get under your arm as if for protection if feeling threatened. Keep meal times peaceful and without loud noises to prevent upsetting his sensitive appetite. Submissive to other animals, Max would kindly give up kibble to make sure everyone is getting along. Max needs to care for someone else and is often seen adopting other animals or children in his environment and treating them as if he were their parent. Give Max lots of attention and reassurance. Daily swims at the lake or pool would be enjoyed. Max is a dog you can count on to lick your tears away and lend you a paw when you are sad or sick.

Sun

Sun Signs give the basic identity of an animal. This is the real side you will see once he trusts you enough to show it to you. Although not always apparent to strangers, to those he lives with, there is no question what Max is really like. The basic needs and patterns in life are strongly governed by the Sun. Where it is found in the chart will influence that area of your dog's life strongly. He will put his best paw forward in this area, being noticed by all.

Sun in Capricorn:

Here is the dog that plans his every move. "If I do this then I will receive a cookie. If I continue to do the same thing maybe I'll receive another cookie or more. Then I can stash them away so if I ever get really hungry..." Max is very methodical in his approach to things. He is a social climber and will not stay at the bottom of the pecking order for long. If you have something Max wants he will be your best friend. Soon Max becomes the leader and everyone looks to him for approval or extra cookies; he always has a hidden stash. Max doesn't care what gets changed in the process, he wants to be number one. Not always affectionate, often seeming stand-offish unless approached. Loyal and dependable, Max gets any job done despite insurmountable odds. He will behave better in obedience than most, because he knows the reward comes later. In Max's life there is also a delayed gratification; often he had a difficult or complicated beginning. He will improve with age so you might want to give this wonderful animal a second chance.

Sun in the 6th house:

These dogs live to serve mankind by service to others. Max needs a job in which he can care for another animal. If Max doesn't feel needed he will not survive. Max will feed and care for other animals and also watch out for you. Being very selective in his food choices, Max would prefer eating a few choice vegetables with his usual carnivore menu. Active of mind and spirit, Max must be kept busy or boredom could bring destructive behavior.

Sun Conjunct Mercury:

Max's intelligence far surpasses that of the average dog. Don't let Max waste time at home when he could be of service to so many. Easy to train and wanting to be involved in all you do. Max understands any form of communication and will attempt to talk back when prompted. Max thinks he is human and will try to make you understand what is important to him. Max needs the company of others and to communicate with them.

Sun Sextile Mars:

Give Max plenty of room to run. Max never stops for long in any one place before he needs to run again. Max seeks the constant attention of all and lives to play. Max will run until he drops. You may need to guard him from exhaustion. Max can play from dawn to dark and still be looking for more. He makes a great running companion, urging you to go the distance. Max may be quick to demonstrate his annoyance with others who try to intimidate or control him. Other animals will have to take a submissive role.

Moon

The Moon tells us how dogs bond with us on an emotional level. Now, we all know dogs have emotions but they show it in different ways. The Moon demonstrates what he really loves in life. This is the treat to their humdrum day. If wanting to know what to buy for a pet look to the moon sign to determine the perfect gift.

Moon in Scorpio:

Max may be aloof to strangers but is always right at your side. Protective to the point of obsession, he may not want to share you or your domain. In tune with your every movement. Your loyalty counts and if you show favoritism to other animals, he may let you know in no uncertain terms. Max has hidden a stash of goodies away from harm and often goes AWOL for short periods so he can spend time with his stuff away from the watchful eye of others. Often after having his feelings hurt he will retreat. Other obligations will not deter him. He needs to feel wanted and an important part of your life. Max will become reclusive and shy without your praise and attention. Loyal and sensitive to your needs, Max often feels it when you're sad or upset. He always manages to bring a smile to your face no matter how bad a day it may be. Max often gives you an expression like he knows what you're thinking. He does, so don't think of leaving without him - Max will often beat you to the door. Max would do well if trained in police work to help find suspects or materials used in a crime.

Moon in the 5th house:

Max can be wonderful with children. Entertaining in all he does, Max lives to bring joy into your life. He feels content in knowing that fun is just around the corner. All he has to do is initiate play and there are many that are game to join him. King of his domain you will always find this dog sitting in the place of honor.

Moon Square Venus:

Max is basically a one-person dog, not allowing others to interfere in the relationship he shares with you. Once you have won Max's affection, he is yours for life. It may take awhile before you can gain his trust. He may find it difficult at times dealing with emotions that you lay on him. Try to give him space and he will eventually bond with you, remaining loyal for life.

Moon Square Uranus:

Max may have shown up on your doorstep quite unexpectedly. Sometimes even missing for days, he returns as if nothing ever happened. He often has another home away from home; Max will never be bored for lack of company. He makes his own friends both animal and human. Success in conformation ring may come suddenly and unexpectedly but his real love is agility. Quick and graceful in movement his body is well suited for the fast movement required to win. Max can be quite happy just chasing a Frisbee or tennis balls. If visiting beaches or seashore you can be sure the sea gulls will be getting a visit from Max. There hasn't been a bird he hasn't wanted to greet personally.

Mercury

Mercury in the chart shows us a little bit about the intelligence of an animal. For every human that is a little slow and methodical in their thinking there is another who is quick and intelligent in their response. Although a dog can't write or talk to us, there is a certain communication that he shares with other animals and humans. Some are quick learners while others take a more practical approach to learning. Mercury shows you strengths or obstacles that may occur in the process.

Mercury in Sagittarius:

These dogs were made for travelling and your Max is no exception. With wanderlust in his heart, he yearns for the time he spends with you on the road. Whether it be in the car or on a winding trail you can't keep Max away from adventure. It seems to find him. Never sure where the next path may take him, he cherishes his time out of the house. Friends with all humans and animals, Max will be submissive if need be to keep peace in the pack. "Let's keep this fun," he seems to say to the other animals. If anyone can be an incentive to exercise Max can. He is always ready to go, picking up the leash or keys to let you know, "Let's go, I've been waiting too long and life is too short."

Mercury in the 6th house:

Max lives to play and socialize with other small animals. Always wanting to help and feel needed, he will bring other animals food or toys. This makes him feel wanted and needed. Max finds contentment in knowing he can serve you - whatever your needs may be.

Mercury Conjunct Sun:

Highly intelligent and intuitive, Max shines in all that he does. There isn't a trick or job too hard for him. The hard part may be in getting Max to do it. Easily bored once a trick or job is mastered he is ready to move on to the next one even though you may not be. Keep Max's mind active by communicating how special he is. Make him feel like he is the smartest dog in the world and he will do anything to prove you right.

Mercury Sextile Mars:

It is to be hoped you are a runner or own a treadmill because Max certainly needs one. Somewhat scattered and erratic in nature, his mind is so active that he can't settle down. There's not enough time in the day for you to exercise Max enough. Always ready for a run, marathons would be more appropriate for these high-energy dogs. Allow them plenty of running room. Venus

Venus specifies the object of desire in a chart. This could be another dog or a favorite toy - it could even be you or another member of the family. When Max sees this object there's no looking back. Venus placement could help you find a suitable match for Max someday. There are soul mates out there for everyone including dogs. Dogs' souls also stand the test of time. Humans are not the only ones governed by karma. Let Venus lead you and your dog to happiness in finding true love.

Venus in Aquarius:

This sensitive soul feels what you do. Max puts you on a pedestal and adores everything you do. Harsh words and reprimands may send Max to his room for hours. Returning to you with his tail between his legs is the only way he knows to repair the damage. Max is so cute with his sensitive eyes you just have to forgive him. It's easy for Max to get beneath your skin and soon he seems to read you and know you better than yourself. His judgment of people can be trusted, often alerting you to anyone not suited to you. Keep Max close by your side and when leaving offer him a piece of your clothing. This way his object of affection is never far away. Max loves frequent trips to ocean and lake. Venus in the 8th house:

Ever wonder why Max looks at you a little funny. Have you noticed how he can read your mind? Do you feel like there is much more behind those big brown eyes than what's on the surface? If there was ever a dog that lived before, Max was probably it and he knew you then. 'Til death do us part and part and part. Max is as much a part of you as time. If only you could read those eyes that long to tell you of prior adventures. He knows you better than you know yourself.

Venus Square Moon:

Max may not always know how to respond to you. If it takes bad behavior to get attention he will use it. Max seems to always be trying to get your affection and not knowing how to do

so. For example, he may bring you his toys until you find one you like and respond. Play time is important because it shows him how much you care.

Venus Conjunct Uranus:

Keeping this dog in one place could prove difficult. Always alert and in motion. It may be difficult for Max to stand still long enough for the required obedience or conformation training. His alertness will prove to be helpful and get him noticed. Unusual in appearance, Max attracts attention like a magnet. He could be noted for something quite out of the ordinary like rescuing people from a fire or other bodily harm. Max may love to travel and airplanes are no exception. Max finds birds intriguing and they and he can become quite fond of one another if introduced early in life.

Venus Sextile Pluto:

Max knows how to show you who's boss. Other animals and humans will show him the respect he deserves. Noticed by judge and strangers alike Max will impress everyone with his soundness and secure sense of being. He seems to radiate an attitude of respect, "Don't mess with me."

Mars

Mars in a chart allows us to see where your dog's energy is and how he might use it. Will he be quick and aggressive or passive and resistant? Let Mars help you decide what activity your dog best qualifies for.

Mars in Libra:

Max is driven to seeing that everyone gets along. If someone is pestering another animal or child in your household he will surely set them straight. He hates it when you're mad and will make up to you anyway he can. Max does better with a partner in life and if you are not always available be sure he has someone else to converse with. It doesn't have to be another dog. Cats and birds will give him the stimuli he needs, although another dog would be the perfect companion to bring out his true nature. Venus is the planet that rules here, making Max attractive to others. Conformation ring can be something he would excel at. Light on his feet he may be able to break a few records in agility as well.

Mars in the 5th house:

Keep Max active in caring for younger animals in the family. This might include your own children as well. Risking all, Max is often seen visiting a special dog in the neighborhood that he is in love with. This may change as frequently as the Moon but he lives for love. Keep him busy with frequent visits from puppies and children.

Mars Sextile Sun:

Energetic and ready for action, Max's whole body and appearance signal that he is ready, willing and able. He may work himself to exhaustion if care is not taken. Tireless and in continuous motion is how you would describe Max. A ball of energy with plenty to spare. Quick to temper - take all warnings seriously. Early obedience training is a good idea. Put all that

energy to good use; find Max a job where he can use up some of it. Running, hunting and adventure are the name of the game for Max. If you can get him to stay still for longer than 5 minutes you've succeeded.

Mars Sextile Mercury:

Intelligence can easily be observed when looking into Max's eyes. Keep this dog active. Search and seize or agility and herding activities are areas Max can succeed in. Include Max in sporting activities especially if it involves games. He needs to socialize and does well in a group. Max can outsmart other animals always bringing back the prize. He just thinks and acts faster than other dogs giving him the edge.

Jupiter

Wherever Jupiter falls in your dog's chart is where he is most likely to find good luck and abundance. Here is where the route to all adventures begins. Follow Jupiter around the chart for an idea of where you can bring Max the most enjoyment. Let him show you how to have fun and enjoy life in his own special way.

Jupiter in Gemini:

Max is one live wire, always trying to talk to you. The chatterbox of the family he can howl his way right into your heart. Max loves all his playmates and will want to be surrounded with them. He is not meant to be alone; if Max can't join you on your daily travels be sure he has company. At least leave the TV or radio on or boredom could present a new set of problems. Who said dogs can't read the paper. Believe me, that paper will be shredded all through the house if Max is left alone for too long. Max is the dog you want to bring to the office with you. Everyone in the neighborhood knows and loves him. His short journeys are known to bring a few smiles to others in your circle. Max visits the multitude of friends he has made throughout the years as often as possible. Having high energy and tuned in to others, Max can help with the herding or gathering together of other animals. He enjoys the trips and visits you include him in and would be lost if you did not bring him along. Not a dog to be left alone, Max enjoys the company of others especially the teenagers in your household.

Jupiter in the 11th house:

Max's friends follow him everywhere. The leader of the pack, Max often initiates play with others including you. Everyone is his friend and many follow him on travels through the neighborhood. A bit self-centered but willing to share if pushed. It could be hard getting Max to change his patterns. Max's friends are important to him and feed into his sense of self-worth. They let him feel important and he allows them into your home as if they belong there.

Jupiter Trine Neptune:

Those large eyes staring at you beneath the layer of fur so needing a trim is bound to win your heart forever. Max sees right through you and right into your soul. He reads you like a book and there's not much you can get away with. He is always in your presence; you'll need a pair of scissors to cut him loose. Max feels what you do and wants to be with you every moment of the day. Guarding you from any intruders by day and sending you to pleasant dreamland at night, Max makes you feel secure in his presence.

Saturn

Saturn in your dog's chart represents the disciplinarian or authority figure. This could be you or his own canine mother. This is the person who sets the limits on obedience and how Max behaves. The rules learned here become known as Max's personal boundaries. Boundaries and limits are meant to be challenged - Max instinctively knows how far he can push you. By learning where Saturn is in Max's chart we find how to manage behavior with a disciplinarian approach he can live with.

Saturn in Taurus:

Max Places more emphasis on the reward than the deed, making training easy. Shower Max with treats and rewards and he can work miracles. Moving heavy objects by sled or digging for hidden treasure, Max finds no work too difficult. His only limit is time out to enjoy his treats. With a tendency toward laziness, Max may not work unless bribed.

Saturn in the 11th house:

Max feels like the only way he can keep his canine buddies is by donating treats or toys that he has collected along the way. Often the youngest in a group of older dogs, Max will be submissive and let others eat and play first. Only by denial of his own gratification until later can he earn the respect required in the dog world. Respecting the older dogs in the group by being submissive makes friendships. Submission may be necessary for him to survive.

Uranus

Uranus, the planet of change and excitement, remains in a sign for approximately 7 years. For this reason it is considered one of the generational planets, affecting large groups of dogs born during the period. Uranus shows us where individualism is strongest. Genius abilities can be evident with the right training. Independence is also strongest here. Change in this area can be accomplished only by communicating on a different level of understanding, for example intuition, natural forces, habit, or other unconventional and inexplicable methods. Information is processed with lightning speed showing a higher intelligence at work.

Uranus in Aquarius:

Unselfish in all he does, Max can impress you with his loving devotion. Caring for all in the family, his humanitarian efforts do not go unnoticed. Max can be seen helping other animals along the way and it is not unheard of for him to bring a few home with him for a free meal. He automatically senses those in need and will try to lend a hand. This does not exclude you and your friends as well. Intuitive to others he senses when there are troubled natures that need some loving attention. Max can direct his attention to those individuals providing them with the gift of love. Through this he has accomplished more than he will ever know. Max can be quite inventive and original when it comes to getting you to try new things. He is often the first to wake you, as his restless spirit does not allow much time for sleep. His intuitive nature will know when you're ready and remind you with a gentle nudge and his leash when it's time to go. Sometimes his erratic behavior may surprise you, but this is only his response to external stimuli he has tuned in to. Of course this is beyond your comprehension unless you're

as tuned in to things as he is. Watch for restless behavior and try to allow Max some degree of independence for him to follow his natural calling to be with others.

Uranus in the 8th house:

Max may have inherited most of his abilities and talent from his canine parents but he stands to benefit from the allowances you make for him. If sudden loss should make you change your circumstances it would be wise to provide for him in a way that would be beneficial to all. Perhaps having an understanding with a breeder to take him back or provide for him after you are gone would be wise.

Uranus Square Moon:

Max is temperamental and resistant to change - it may take more than your usual treats to get him to see things your way. Today you're the object of his affection; tomorrow your partner or a neighbor has replaced you. Max can't seem to make up his mind who he gives his attention to.

Uranus Conjunct Venus:

A sudden attraction to Max may have you taking him home without planning. You just can't resist these marvelous creatures. Almost magnetic to others, Max will have the admiration of many as well.

Neptune

Neptune gives you a view into your dog's soul. It shows us the mystical magical side to him that makes him tick. What is Max's soul purpose in life? Is it to belong to you or does he have a greater mission? The house that Neptune is found in is where Max will sacrifice all to obtain a higher position in your eyes. Neptune takes about 14 years to complete its cycle through one sign. Many generations of dogs will have Neptune in the same sign therefore house placement will be more important, with emphasis on the activities of the house.

Neptune in Aquarius:

Max's conception of others is derived from his intuition as well as his other senses. He communicates by telepathy and does not understand why you cannot understand. He feels a part of all beings and the connection he makes with others is quite interesting. Max desires to help others and belong to the group. This is quite evident. Activities that are done with large groups of animals can be something Max enjoys and looks forward to. Enjoying the feeling of being a part of the masses, Max performs best with others.

Neptune in the 8th house:

Max owns not only you but your thoughts as well. If any dog can control you this one can. Max will make it a point to take up every waking moment of your day. Sensitive to your reprimand, Max can be seen retreating to his own private areas until ready to forgive you. Even treats won't bring him out until he is good and ready.

Neptune Trine Jupiter:

Somehow Max is saved from his own overindulgences and comes out ahead. He has no limits and likes to do things in a big way. His imagination can get the better of him when he envisions himself as one big killing machine. Meantime Max may only weigh 10 pounds but his bark and attitude make him seem larger. At least in Max's mind. In most cases Max is able to pull it off but will need to be watched when around more aggressive animals.

Pluto

Pluto in Max's chart shows where he has the greatest potential. Through instruction and sometimes change he can achieve mastery of any skill you teach him. Instinctively Max knows, as if from a prior lifetime, exactly how to do things, even if he was never taught before. Never having experienced a specific activity before and without prior knowledge, Max can be an expert at this activity expressed by the house in which Pluto is located.

Pluto in Sagittarius:

Max has enough adventure in him to provide you with entertainment for life. Almost goofy in his antics he can give you hours of fun. Follow him to wooded paths where Max can hunt, trail and raise prey just for entertainment. Provide Max with ample outdoor play time where he can roam in the wild.

Pluto in the 6th house:

Obsessive about taking care of other members in the household, Max rarely has time for himself. Always the boss, Max will be the alpha dog in the house and at work. He is helpful in healing others and would be wonderful at canine good citizen activities. His visits would bring the positive feeling necessary to assist with the healing of those he visited.

Pluto Sextile Venus:

It's not hard to fall in love with Max. He simply adores you and shows you every chance he gets. Very affectionate to all members of the family. The bonds he forms with you are strong and unchallenged.
